Dear Mr. Trimarco:

Thank you for your assistance in the above-entitled action. As you know, Mr. Felix was accused of sexually molesting two of his students at the middle school where he was employed as a seventh grade teacher. Each of the fifteen counts against him carried a mandatory life sentence allegation.

From the beginning, Mr. Felix has denied engaging in the type of substantial sexual conduct alleged by the girls. As a result of the polygraph test administered to Mr. Felix, the District Attorney's office has finally come around to the opinion that the girls probably were exaggerating the extent of the touching that took place. As such, they have dismissed all the life allegations against Mr. Felix. He still faces a lengthy sentence for the conduct he actually did engage in, but it is a far, far lesser amount than was previously contemplated.

Without your invaluable assistance, I doubt the truth of what really occurred would ever have been discerned.
